APPELLATION HAUT-MEDOC

LOCATION AND SOIL

The Château Coufran vineyard is located to the north of Saint-Seurin-de-Cadourne running along the river, a town neighbouring Saint-Estèphe in the Pauillac area.

It stretches across a hillside, with its highest point at 21 metres in altitude (benefits greatly from the influence of the Gironde Estuary and the Atlantic Ocean).

The soil is composed of a single 76-hectare block, with soils primarily made up of gravel and clay.

In tight-grain French oak barrels during 12 months, with ¼ renewed each year.

TYPE OF WINE

With 85% of Merlot, Château COUFRAN is called the « Pomerol of Médoc». Unique for a Haut-Medoc “typically Merlot”.

Rich, opulent with pretty aromas of berry and cherry. Full-bodied palate, with a long finish. Old vines

The old Merlots of this vintage give it an aptitude for certain aging.
